



parched, lifeless, and without water", it evokes the desires of one's heart for the presence of the Lord in his life. Nothing else on this earth satisfies our longing for Him, the same situation Jeremiah faced when he resolved to turn to the Lord.

How does one achieve a deep relationship with our Savior the way the psalmist and Jeremiah have? The 2nd reading advises us: "Do not conform yourselves to this age but be transformed by the renewal of your mind, that you may discern what is the will of God, what is good and pleasing and perfect."

To discern the will of God, that which is good and pleasing and perfect, means aspiring for spiritual matters over earthly things. The Lord knows that while we continue to exist on earth, we will get distracted from our heavenly goal. When we spend more of our time pursuing our personal

agenda, we will find ourselves slacking in prayer time. And prayer, both personal and communal, is an essential means to connect with the Lord and become grounded in His true reality. Without prayer and worship, we can never discover what the Lord wants of us. It won't be His voice that we hear. It will be our own voice, with our own wants and desires, that we listen to. On the other hand, when our mind is not renewed, we can memorize prayers, do devotions endlessly, go to mass daily but not fully understanding what it really means of Him being the Way, the Truth, and the Life.

Being a disciple of Jesus entails hardship. Now as we grow older, we become conscious of the quality of our lives. In the financial field, people talk of putting the maximum contribution to reach a goal of comfortable living. The sobering words of Jesus in the Gospel challenge us to think not what

we prefer, but what God wants. Jesus stresses self-denial while following Him. We let go of our human ambitions and accept suffering and rejections when faced with conflict. Pride does not occupy our hearts when we try to carry out His will. We are willing to forgive those who wronged us even when to many people it meant being weak and foolish. We value our time spent on earth only in the context of doing what pleases the Lord. Despite the challenges of being His disciple, we move ahead to complete our mission with renewed determination and perseverance. We are able to persevere for we know we will be rewarded eternally according to our conduct here on earth. So what kind of investment are you willing to give up now to gain a foothold in heaven? Think about the consequence of your choices now. Are you willing to follow Him all the way to the end?
