### REFLECTION:

"O you of little faith, why did you doubt?" (Mt 14: 31). These are the words Jesus spoke to Peter when he lost sight of Him amidst the storm. In our struggles in life, the Lord speaks to us and invites us to come to Him in faith, but such faith must be unwavering. To God, sincerity in our faith is what matters, and as we journey in life through all our trials and difficulties, the more our faith should remain strong. Our theme this week tells

us – Our faith in Jesus Christ remains strong when we take courage and put our full trust in Him. In humble prayer, we come to Jesus and ask Him to increase our faith, most especially when your faith is too small and weak. Little by little, we are able to build up our faith through reception of the Sacraments, worship, reflecting on His words, and even doing corporal and spiritual works of mercy. Faith will definitely grow its roots as we consciously act and live in faith.



The miracle of Peter walking on water was shortlived because he lost his focus on Jesus. Like Peter, when we take our eves off Jesus, we can be quickly overwhelmed by the storms of our life. When we stop seeking Jesus, we sink into our problems and we get sucked into temptations, and if we are not careful, it may be difficult to rise up again. But Jesus promised that He will always be with us, that true peace can only be found in His presence. He promised that we will endure all our

struggles with Him by our side and we can move forward in the midst of all trials. Sometimes, Jesus calls us out of our "boat" and comfort zones, to come to Him and follow His commands. And even with all our concerns and fears, we obey Him. Yet, when we feel afraid or unsure, Jesus is right there to catch us when we fail or stumble.

We must not hesitate to cry out, "Lord save us! We are perishing!" (Mt. 8: 25). This act of humility and faith is a prayer itself;



### Pride Only In The Lord

While human praise does not tempt the Lord, people are often ruffled and nearly entranced by human praise and honors in the church. Peter was afraid on the sea, terrified by the

great force of the storm. Indeed, who does not fear that voice: 'Those who say you are happy place you in error and disturb the path of your feet' (Isaiah 3:12 Vulgate translation)? And since the soul struggles against the desire for human praise, it is good for it to turn to prayer and petition amid such danger, lest one who is charmed by praise be overcome by criticism and reproach. Let Peter, about to sink in the waves, cry out and say, "Lord, save me!" The Lord reached out his hand. He chided Peter, saying, "O man of little faith, why did you doubt?" - that is, why did you not, gazing straight at the Lord as you approached, pride yourself only in him? Nevertheless he snatched Peter from the waves and did not allow him who was declaring his weakness and asking the Lord for help to perish.

• Not only have you found the pearl of great price but I have wholeheartedly given it to you. Love it, nourish it, nurture it, and allow it to grow in your heart and in your life.




- My children you are all precious to Me. Follow Me. I desire to bring you all to My kingdom.
