REFLECTION:

We celebrate the ascension of our Lord Jesus Christ to commemorate the completion of His mission to fulfill God's plan. He ascended to the Father in His resurrected body so that all of us may ascend with Him in His divinity. It marks the end of Jesus' life on earth, and the beginning of our sharing the heavenly life because we are invited to follow Christ, if we believe, live and share

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ,


